TANNERS, &c. (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Tanners, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in or in connection with the industries of tanning and leather dressing, of the handling, bagging or grinding of bark or the manufacture of bark and other tanning extracts, and of the washing or treatment of animal hair with tanning, dyeing or other treatment of furs and other skins, in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees within the jurisdiction of the Forestry Employees (State) Conciliation Committee.

2. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

3. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.

4. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, New South Wales Branch.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 1 September 1995.
