INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees' Association, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

(No. IRC 618 of 1996)

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Bespoke Bootmakers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All persons employed in the making of footwear to special order (bespoke bootmakers) and repairers and heel bar operatives in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Retail Traders' Association of New South Wales and one by the Footwear Repairers' Association of New South Wales, alternate nominating rights, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees' Association, New South Wales, and one by the Shop Assistants and Warehouse Employees' Federation of Australia, Newcastle and Northern, New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 10 April 1996.
